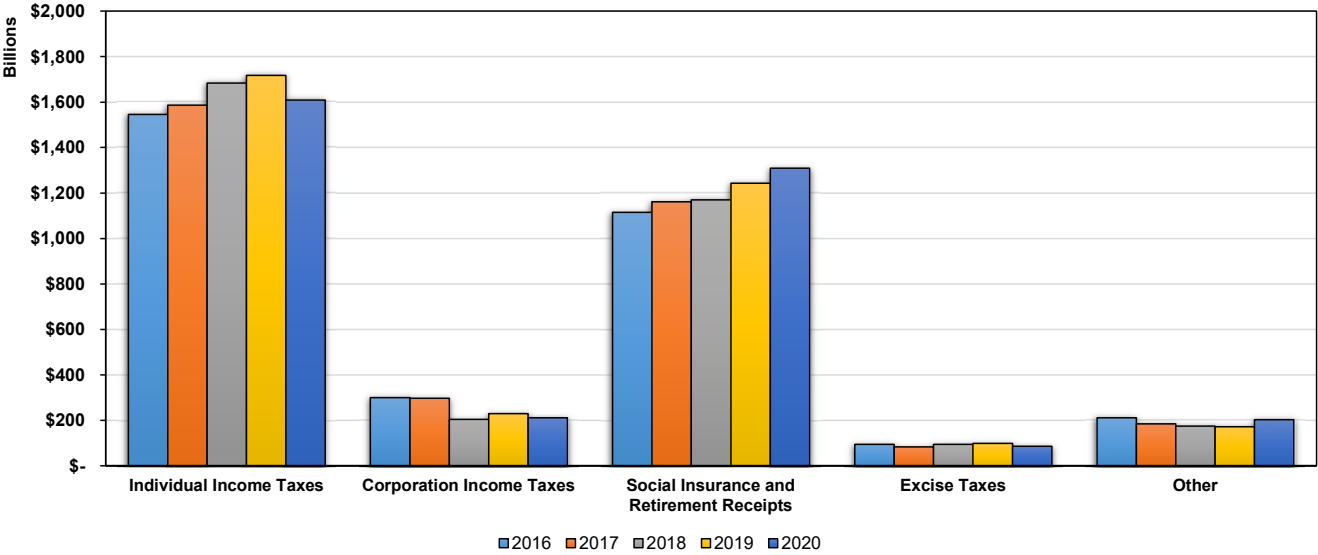
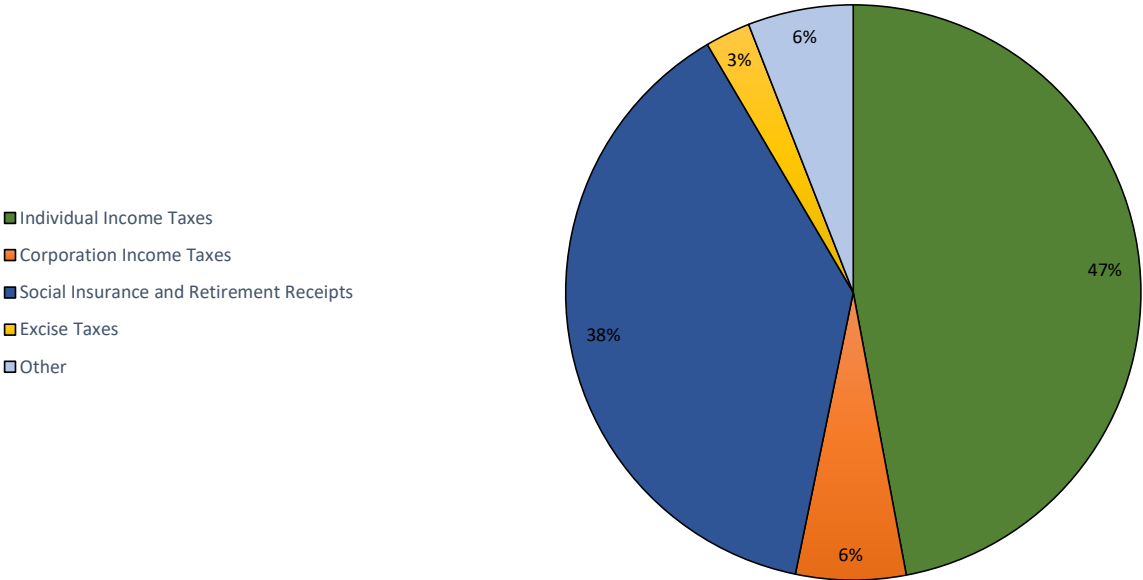


RECEIPTS BY SOURCE - SUMMARY

Total receipts for the United States Government in fiscal year 2020 were \$3,420.0 billion, a decrease of 1.2 percent or \$42.3 billion below the amount from fiscal year 2019. The chart below shows total receipts divided by source.

Changes in receipts by source are discussed briefly in the text below. The table that follows depicts the amount of receipts for fiscal years 2020 and 2019 by source, including the amount and percentage of changes from fiscal year 2019.

- . **Individual Income Taxes** were \$1,608.7 billion in fiscal 2020, a decrease of 6.4 percent or \$109.2 billion below the prior fiscal year.
- . **Corporation Income Taxes** were \$211.8 billion in fiscal 2020, a decrease of 8.0 percent or \$18.4 billion below the prior fiscal year.
- . **Social Insurance and Retirement Receipts** were \$1,310.0 billion in fiscal year 2020, an increase of 5.4 percent or \$66.8 billion above the prior fiscal year.
 - . **Employment and General Retirement** contributions were \$1,261.7 billion in fiscal year 2020, an increase of 5.4 percent or \$64.3 billion above the prior fiscal year.
 - . **Unemployment Insurance** receipts were \$43.1 billion in fiscal year 2020, an increase of 5.3 percent or \$2.2 billion above the prior fiscal year.
 - . **Other Retirement** contributions were \$5.2 billion in fiscal year 2020, an increase of 8.6 percent or \$0.4 billion above the prior fiscal year.
- . **Excise Taxes** were \$86.8 billion in fiscal 2020, a decrease of 12.3 percent or \$12.1 billion below the prior fiscal year.
- . **Other**, including estate and gift taxes, customs duties, and miscellaneous receipts were \$202.7 billion in fiscal year 2020, an increase of 17.8 percent or \$30.6 billion above the prior fiscal year.
 - . **Estate and Gift Taxes** were \$17.6 billion in fiscal 2020, an increase of 5.7 percent or \$1.0 billion above the prior fiscal year.
 - . **Customs Duties** were \$68.6 billion in fiscal 2020, a decrease of 3.2 percent or \$2.2 billion below the prior fiscal year.
 - . **Miscellaneous Receipts** were \$116.5 billion in fiscal 2020, an increase of 37.7 percent or \$31.9 billion above the prior fiscal year.
